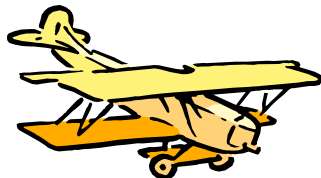

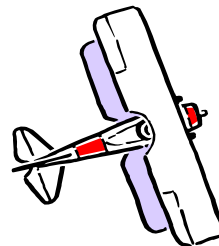
## Minutes of June 7th, 2004 Meeting

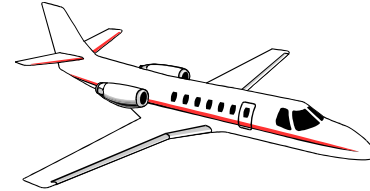


A new award category for Chapter 315's Outstanding Host of meetings during the year - to Eli Liebermann, who, unfortunately was not present to claim his award...

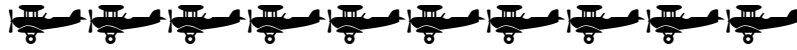

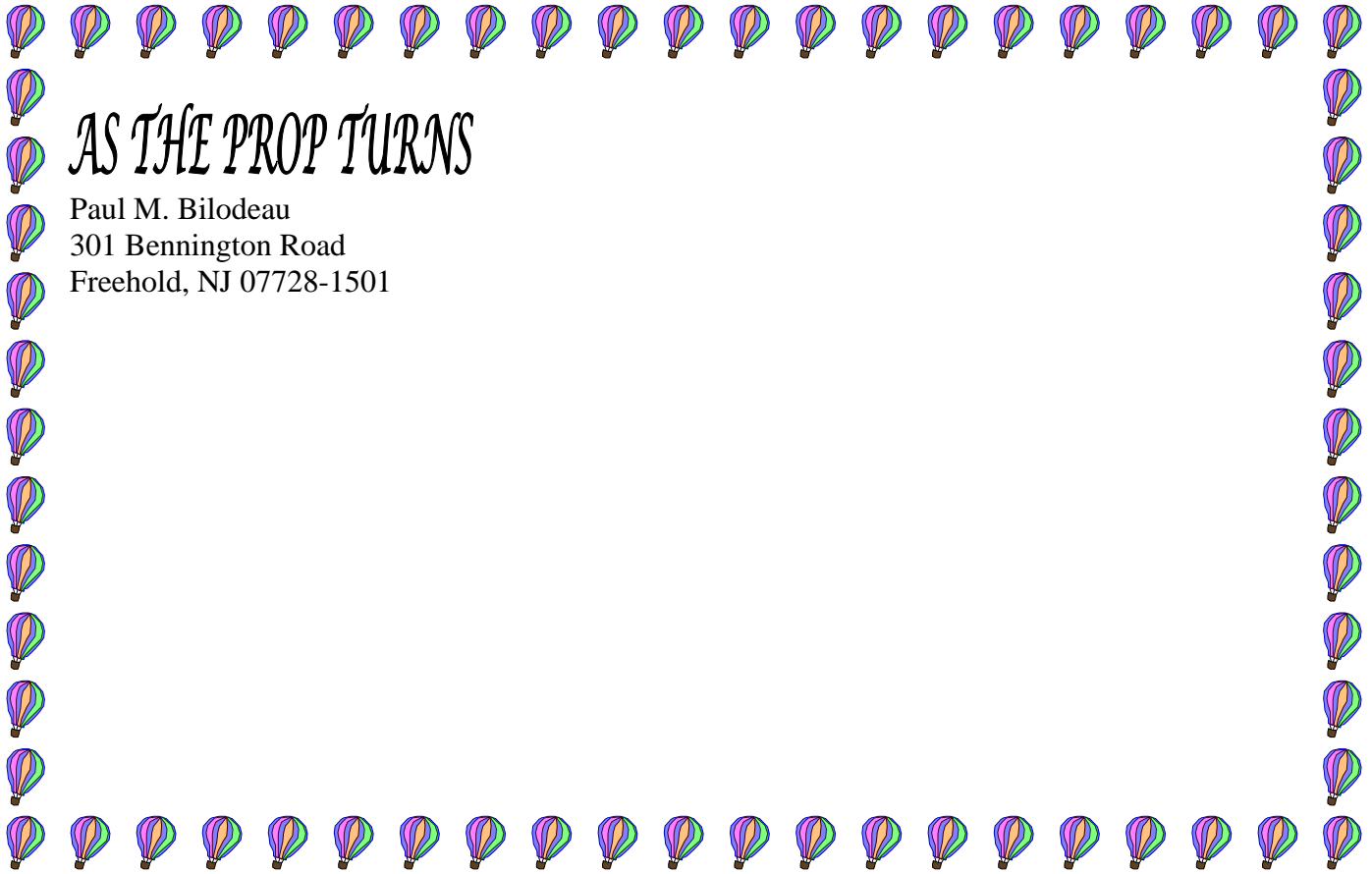
