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Minutes of the Meeting, December 11th, 2006

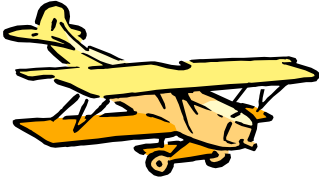
Meeting was called to order by President Glenn Stott at 7:35PM.

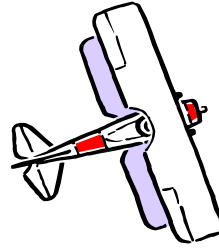

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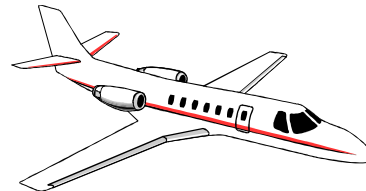
OLD BUSINESS

- Roger told us a story about his friend, John Foster, who met Carol Ann Garrett. He was the first controller to speak with her when she flew back into the US. Carol Ann is now building an airplane that she plans to fly around the world again.



NEW BUSINESS



- Eli Liebermann's RV-6A had its first flight on 12/10/2006. Everything went well. The test pilot reported clean stall at 50mph, speed in level flight was 175mph with a 180HP engine. Eli insured the airplane prior the first flight. The airplane took 10 years to build. **Congratulations!!!**
- Dick Agusty mentioned that our Internet domain registration fee of \$35 is due in January. We need to consider another place to host our web site. Typically the cost would be about \$150/year.
- We need to start planning our annual awards dinner. Everyone agreed to have it at Woody's Tavern again, as we all liked the place and the food. The dinner will take place at the end of March or beginning of April, since Sun-n-Fun does not start until 4/17/2007.
- Two American pilots held by Brazilian authorities since the mid-air collision of 737 and a corporate jet have been released. Both pilots are from NY.

- New Jersey proposed building a large sports complex near the Millville Airport. The complex would include a NASCAR race track. AOPA is opposing this idea due to concern about effect on the airport operations. Since NASCAR tracks have many people near them during racing events it is likely that the airspace nearby would be closed with TFRs at those times.
- FAA has redefined "known icing" conditions as "high humidity and cold temperatures".
- Starting from January 23rd, 2007 you will need to have a passport to re-enter the US. Even when traveling from Canada.
- Chapter renewal documents have been sent in to headquarters.
- 50/50 was won by Dick Augusty. He received the sum of \$12.

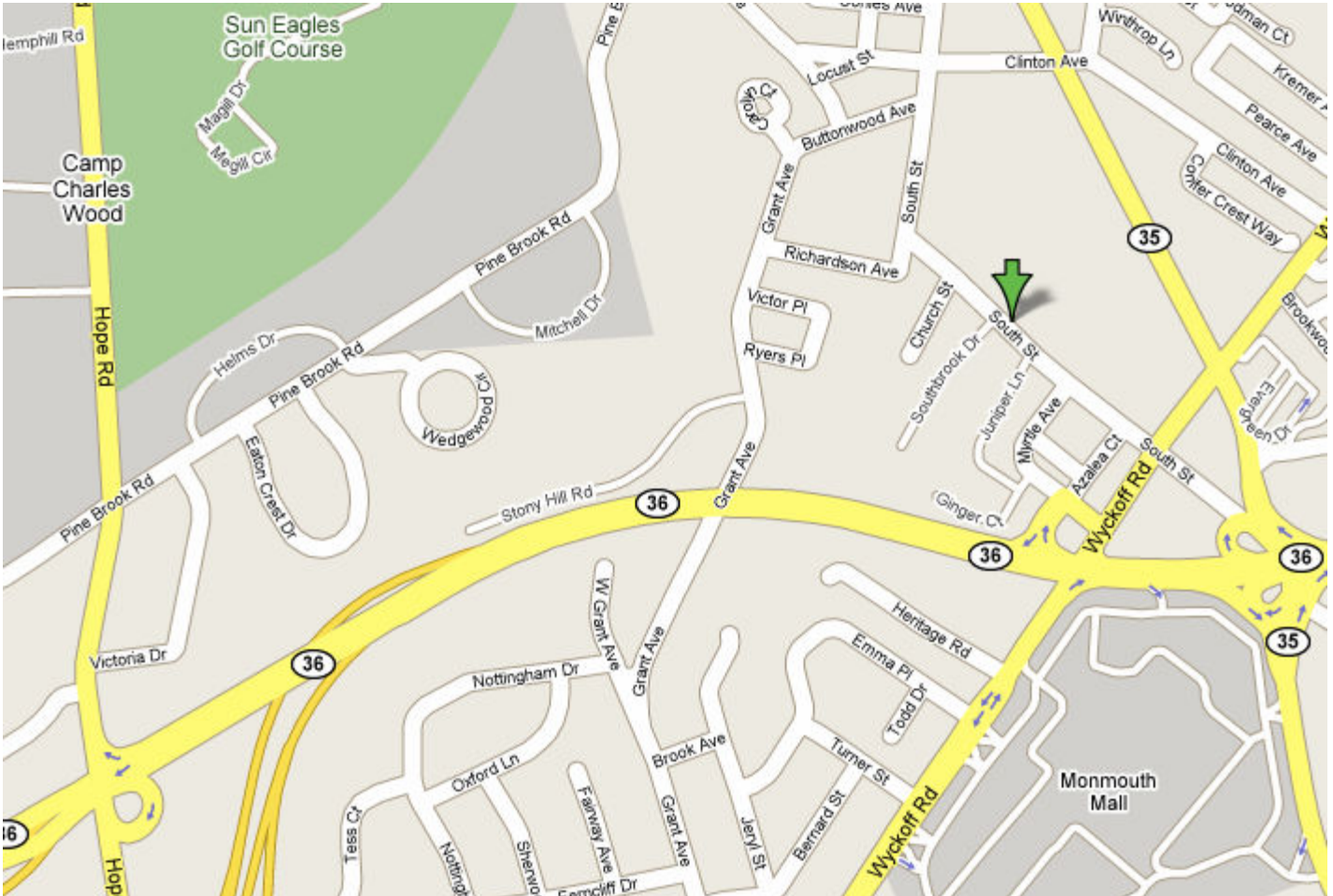
Radar: Cessna 4675, go ahead

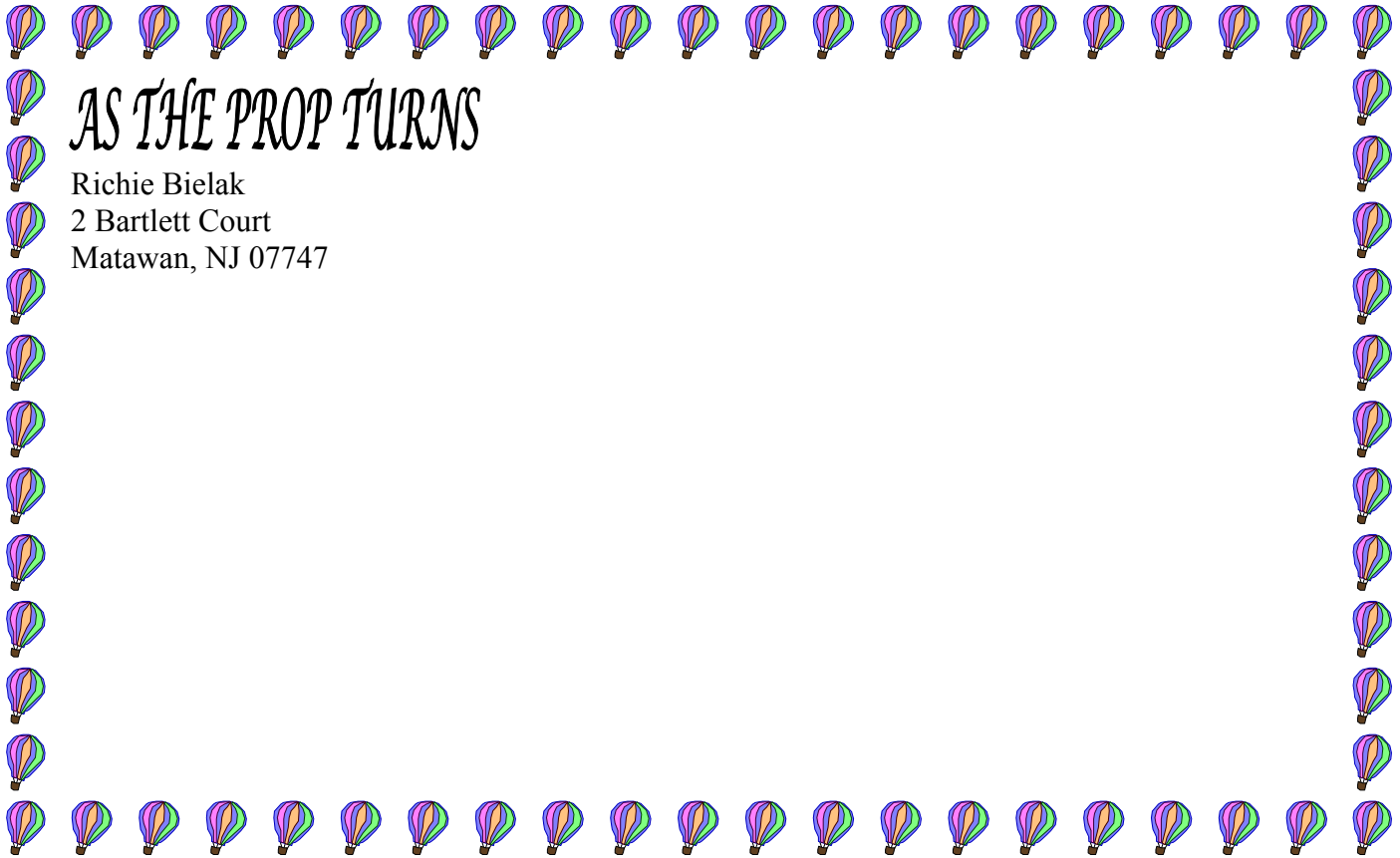
